



Do you fall into one of the following,

- Your child is on Free School Meals,
- Looked after Children
- You are struggling to pay the bills or having financial difficulties of some sort.

Then we may be able to help you. The Extended Opportunities Fund is a government fund aimed at helping your children to do activities or go to clubs outside of school hours, i.e. before/after school, during lunchtime, weekends, half-terms or holidays.

We may be able to help you with subscription fees, equipment, kits, club uniforms, transport costs to/from activities. These activities/clubs could help children and young people keep fit and active, learn/try something new and make new friends.

Examples of activities covered are Sports (of all sorts: football, swimming, gym, cheerleading, trampolining etc.), Arts and Drama, Music, Scouts, after school clubs, half-term or holiday activities and schemes.
