

Sixth Form Dress Code

(Pilot in first instance until August 2012)

The 2011/12 dress code is designed to promote Mount Grace Sixth Form with a high profile, both within the school and local community. Students should be aware that they are senior members of the school and represent the school to the public. The clothes that they wear are therefore a very visible indication of the standards the school expects. The code recognises that school is a place of work. There are some special regulations for students studying PE and/ or more practical subjects. Please read this document carefully and come to school dressed appropriately.

General Boys Wear

Trousers and jacket or suit

Shirt with collar; a tie is optional **except** on special occasion days

Shoes

N.B. If lessons are being taken at Chancellors a tie **must** be worn.

General Girls Wear

Trousers or Skirts with shirt or blouse or a suit

Dress

(Girls should not have plunging necklines and skirts must be of a respectable length.)

P.E, Music, Drama and Science

PE Students: MGS track suit; black MGS shorts and MGS PE top in red, black or white. The tracksuit can be worn around the school on days that students are predominantly taking PE. On other days students must dress as stated above.

Music and Drama students may choose to wear the department polo shirts on days that they study drama or music. These should be worn with smart trousers/skirts and shoes.

In some science lessons students will be asked to wear a laboratory coat.

Casual Days

On days when a casual dress code is appropriate, students will be notified on the electronic notice boards in the sixth form area.

In all cases the final decision about the appropriateness of dress will rest with Mrs Davies.
