I am sure that you are already aware that your son or daughter has a GCSE English Literature Examination scheduled for the afternoon of Friday 13th January.

As we try to do whenever there is a board set examination, we are proposing to give all Yr10 students some additional time on the morning of the exam for study.

This will mean that students will not be required to attend school until 1.15pm on this Friday.

- Students will need to check their seating allocation in advance – allow time for this.
- Full uniform is expected. Anyone without full uniform may be refused entry and this will have an impact upon their grade.

Pupils are to revise according to the directions of their teachers and should be completing at least 1hr revision each evening preparation if they want to maximise their exam potential.
