**Assignment Title/Theme:** Collect the research needed to carry out the design task – ‘Scrumptious salad’

**Objectives:**

- develop a range of research skills
- develop presentation skills

**Tasks:**

This research activity is the start of a design project – ‘Scrumptious Salads’ In order to come up with exciting design ideas in class, you will need a range of useful research pages. Carry out all the tasks for your target level. Use pictures, colour, photographs, graphs and charts wherever possible.

Present each page on a new Research sheet with a clear title.

1. Produce an inspiration sheet showing pictures of as many foods you can think of to put in a salad. Cut out pictures of fruits, vegetables, dressings, etc and arrange them in a collage.
2. Make a list of all the different fruits and vegetables you can think of that you could put in a salad.
3. Make a list of the entire carbohydrate foods, meats, fish and dressings ingredient you could add to the salads.

4. Look in recipe books, supermarkets, and supermarket websites and to see what salads exist at present. Include pictures and ingredients. Present your findings clearly and attractively.
5. Carry out a survey to find out what ingredients people would like in a salad and present your results in an interesting way. – tally chart, bar chart, pictograph etc.
