Assignment Title/Theme: PHOTO FRAME AND PACKAGING

Objectives:

- To develop research skills
- To develop presentation skills
- To reinforce prior knowledge of typography
- To develop drawing and colour rendering skills.
- To learn about plastics

<p>Tasks: <u>Inspiration Board:</u> Find lots of pictures of as many different types of photo frames as you can. Cut them out very carefully and arrange them as a collage on an A3 sheet of paper. <u>Research:</u> Look at a range of packaging which have a clear plastic compartment for holding the product. This plastic is called 'blister' packaging. Some examples are ; packaging which hold a new toothbrush or one that holds a mobile phone case. On an A4 research sheet , make a list of all the information and symbols which appear on the packaging, e.g. instructions, recyclable etc. and look at the various ways the <u>blister</u> packaging is formed and presented together with its backing card.</p>	<p>Level 3-4</p>
<p><u>Typography:</u> 1. Look at and collect a range of different fonts [styles of writing] on packaging products. 2. Using packaging, magazines and the internet, cut out a range of different lettering styles and logos and stick on a research sheet and write about the styles of writing and how they have used colour to create effect. 3. Choose a well known logo and redraw in the same style of writing and colour on a piece of A4 paper.</p>	<p>Level 4-5</p> <p>To obtain levels 4 -5 you must also complete the above tasks</p>
<p>Find out about the types of plastics used for a variety of different types of packaging e.g. Chocolate boxes, children's toys, take away foods etc. Say why the plastic is best suited for the product, give a detailed explanation.</p>	<p>Level 5-7/8</p> <p>To obtain levels 5 -7/8 you must also complete all the above tasks</p>
