Assignment Title/Theme: To research and find out the different types of food that is sold in a Bistro style restaurant.

Objectives:

- To develop research skills
- To develop presentation skills

<p>Tasks:</p> <p>Inspiration Board Find lots of clear colourful pictures of ingredients and dishes that you might find in a Bistro. Cut them out carefully and present them on an A4 or an A3 sheet of paper.</p> <p>Research of Existing Recipes.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Collect and neatly arrange (stick onto research paper) a selection of different recipes you like, that could be sold in a Bistro. Present the recipes neatly on A4 Landscape paper. 	<p>Level 3-4</p>
<p>Questionnaire</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. To help you design a main course dish that could be sold in a Bistro, design a questionnaire. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Think of 5-6 questions you might ask people about the food you are creating and the ingredients that you could use. Think of at least 4 or more possible answers to your question b. Write or type out the questions in the order you want them on a sheet of paper. E.g. What type of food do you like to eat? Mexican, Italian etc. What is your favourite ingredient? c. Print out 10 copies of your questionnaire (you could fit 3 or 4 to a page). 3. Now give out your questionnaire to 10 people (all from your target market.) Ask them to fill it in and collect them in again. Tally up the results for each question. 	<p>Level 4-5</p> <p>To obtain levels 4 -5 you must also complete the above tasks</p>

Present your results. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start with a heading on your page and an explanation of how you carried out your task – how many people, age group etc • Present the results for each question in a graph or chart. Use colour. You may do this by hand or use excel. <p>Sum up and explain what your have found out</p> 	<p>Level 5-7/8</p> <p>To obtain levels 5 -7/8 you must also complete all the above tasks</p>
